Player Code of Conduct

Purpose

This Code sets the standard of behaviour expected from all players taking part in JBA activities, including training, matches and events. It is designed to ensure a positive, safe and inclusive badminton environment where everyone feels welcome, supported and respected.

Respect and fair play

As a JBA player, I will:

- Treat everyone equally and with respect, regardless of age, gender, background, ability or beliefs.
- Play fairly and by the rules, showing respect to teammates, opponents, coaches, volunteers and officials.
- Accept referees' and coaches' decisions without arguing - my coach will raise any issues on my behalf if needed.
- Support others by applauding good effort and sportsmanship from all players, win or lose.
- Never use offensive, aggressive, or discriminatory language or behaviour.

Conduct and responsibility

I will:

- Arrive on time, wearing correct kit and ready to train or compete.
- Listen to my coaches and follow instructions with a positive attitude.
- Always try my best and take pride in improving my skills and behaviour.
- Use equipment responsibly and look after the venue and facilities.
- Take responsibility for my actions and set a good example for others.

Safe and inclusive environment

- I understand JBA is committed to creating a safe, inclusive space for everyone.
- I will follow safeguarding, equality, and anti-doping rules as set by JBA, Badminton England, and other authorities.
- If I see or experience anything that worries me or makes me feel unsafe, I will speak to a coach, the Club Welfare Officer (Samuel Jones), or a trusted adult.

Social media

I will:

- Represent myself and JBA positively online and in public.
- Never post negative or inappropriate comments about players, coaches, parents, or officials.

Additional expectations for junior players (Under 18)

As a junior player, I will also:

- Have fun, enjoy learning, and help others enjoy the game too.
- Act safely and responsibly at all times.
- Be honest and never cheat.
- Be kind - help my opponents if they fail and accept apologies.
- Understand that I represent JBA and should always behave like a role model.

Breaches

- Any breach of this code may result in appropriate action by JBA and, where necessary, referral to Badminton England in line with its disciplinary procedures.
